Practical Information

Welcome

The Indonesian Red Cross Society (*Palang Merah Indonesia - PMI*) extends our warmest welcome to all participants of **3rd South East Asia Youth Forum** that will take place in Bali, Indonesia from 2nd-5th September 2024.

Expected Participants

Three representatives from each National Society are expected to participate in the event:

- 1. NS Youth Leader
- 2. NS Youth Representative
- 3. National Staff Youth

Visa

Citizens of ASEAN member countries, such as Brunei Darussalam, the Philippines, Cambodia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Singapore, Thailand, Timor Leste and Vietnam, are eligible for visa-free entry to Indonesia with a maximum period of 30 (thirty) days and cannot be extended. The visa will be granted directly at immigration border control if all requirements are met.

Before entering Indonesia, kindly ensure that your passport has the validity minimum 6 (six) months with the return air flight ticket.

Arrival and Departure date

The meeting will officially start on 2nd September and will be finished on 5th September 2024. Participants will be also requested to attend the dialog session with the Leaders in the morning of 6th September. Kindly plan your arrival to the venue in Bali on 1st September 2024 and we suggest you arrange your departure on the 6th September 2024 afternoon.

After claiming your luggage, you will be passing through the Customs by filling out the Electronic Customs Declaration shown in QR code format. Kindly visit <u>https://ecd.beacukai.go.id/</u> and presented the QR code to the Customs Office.

Meeting Venue

The South East Asia Youth Forum will take place in "**Pulau Bali**" meeting room at Bintang Bali Resort on 2nd September 2024 starting from 9 AM Local Time.

Meals

PMI will provide meals during the event $(2^{nd} - 6^{th}$ September), participants are kindly requested to arrange their own meals on the arrival day. The hotel will serve Halal food. Please notify us if you have any dietary restrictions.

Cost

• Travel

Travel costs and flight arrangements to/from Jakarta, airport taxes and fees, local transport, perdiem, travel insurance will not be covered by the host National Society.

• Accommodation

The host National Society will cover all National Societies accommodation costs (hotel room and meeting facilities) for the approved participants (3 persons from each National Society). The participants will stay in share room (2 persons each room) and possibility to mix with other National Societies delegation. Coffee breaks and lunches will be provided during the meeting.

The other expenses including additional hotel expenses such as additional guest in the room, laundry, mini bar service, internet, telephone calls, faxes, taxi fares, early or late check in etc. are the responsibility of each delegation to be settled before leaving the hotel.

Participants should note that the check-in time is 14:00 in the afternoon and check-out time is 12:00 at noon.



Transportation

Airport transportation will be provided for the approved participants. Kindly share with us your confirmed flight schedules.

• Arrival Day (1st September 2024)

After you claim/collect your luggage and pass through airport's customs channels you will enter the arrival hall. Once you exit, kindly look out the signage of PMI and Bintang Bali Resort.



• Departure Day (6th September 2024)

The Hotel will take the delegation at the Bali Bintang Resort no later than 3 (three) hours before your flight.

Bali, as most of the areas in Indonesia, has a tropical monsoon climate, with two seasons: rainy and dry. The average temperatures of between 21 and 31 degrees Celsius where you will feel comfortable all month long. The weather in September is expected to be warm, sunny and almost rain-free. However, we suggest you to bring an umbrella. The hotel provides an umbrella inside the room to be used during your stay.

The meeting room will be air-conditioned; participants are advised to bring a light jacket/pullover for the meeting hours.



Electricity



In Indonesia the standard voltage is 230 V. The standard frequency is 50 Hz. The power sockets that are used are of type C / F (with two round holes plug). You can use your electric appliances in Indonesia, if the standard voltage in your country is in between 220V - 240V (as in the UK, Europe, Australia and most of Asia and Africa). Manufacturers take these small deviations into account. If the standard voltage in your country is in the range of 100V - 127V (as in the US, Canada and most South American countries), you need a power (voltage) converter.

To be sure, check the label on the appliance. If it states 'INPUT: 100-240V, 50/60 Hz', it can be used in all countries of the world (like chargers for tablets/laptops, photo cameras, cell phones, toothbrushes)

Language

Bahasa Indonesia is the official language. English is commonly spoken by people living in big cities, including Bali, the younger generation and those in the tourist industry.

Currency

The local currency is Indonesian Rupiah which is equivalent to IDR 16,200 to a US dollar. Currency can be exchanged at the airport or any bank or at the hotel or exchange bureau. Automated teller machines (ATM) are readily available.
